OUR PARISH RESUMES PUBLIC ACTIVITY

The parish will begin the gradual restoration of public activity. We are grateful for the opportunity to gather, but we do so with prudence and care to ensure the health and safety of all. Please exercise patience and understanding as we follow the required norms for social distancing. Please note our tentative schedule for resuming public activities.

MONDAY, MAY 11-17, 2020:

The church building will reopen with a limited schedule to allow for people to come and pray or to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Appropriate social distancing will be required. People may be denied entrance upon arrival or asked to leave if the numbers become greater than social distancing would allow. The Adoration Chapel will remain closed. Other public meetings and gatherings will continue to be suspended. Weekday and Sunday Masses will continue to be accessible virtually via the internet.

MONDAY, MAY 18-29, 2020:

Regularly scheduled celebrations of weekday Masses will resume and will be open to parishioners. Appropriate social distancing will be required. People may be denied entrance upon arrival or asked to leave if the numbers become greater than social distancing would allow. The Adoration Chapel will remain closed. Other public meetings and gatherings will continue to be suspended. Sunday Mass will continue to be accessible virtually via the internet.

PENTECOST, MAY 29-30, 2020:

Regularly scheduled celebrations of Saturday-vigil and Sunday Masses will resume and be open to parishioners. Appropriate social distancing will be required. People may be denied entrance upon arrival or asked to leave if the numbers become greater than social distancing would allow. The Adoration Chapel will remain closed. Other public meetings and gatherings will be individually assessed according to circumstance and need before being permitted to resume.

We are pleased to welcome everyone to our parish to pray, to participate in the sacraments, to grow in faith, and to encounter the love of our Lord, Jesus Christ. We appreciate your flexibility and cooperation as our activities will continue to be limited and social distancing norms followed.
