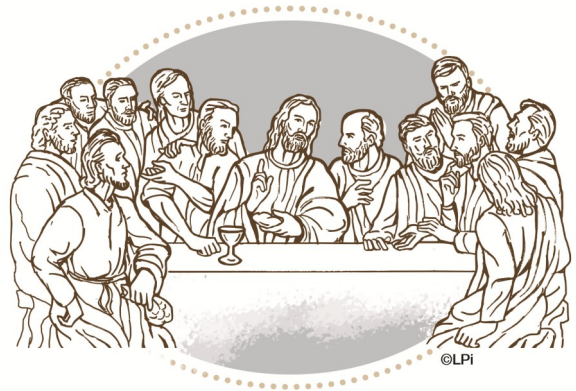

ACTIVE PARISHIONER GUIDELINES

A Registered and Active family/individual is one who:

1. Has formally registered and is participating in the life of the parish community for at least three months.
2. Attends Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation
3. Contributes financially to the parish according to ones means
4. Places the offertory envelope each week in the collection basket, or participates in online or electronic giving.

Active member status in our database is essential for requesting the following:

- Parishioner tuition rate at a Catholic School.
- Endorsement to serve as a sacramental sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation
- To receive the Sacraments of First Holy Communion, Confirmation or Marriage (for oneself or for one's children) at St. Joseph.

MASS INTENTION GUIDELINES

- Mass intentions are scheduled on a rolling three-month schedule. Requests for the newest month open on the first day of each month (e.g. on November 1, requests for January open).
- To ensure all parishioners have an opportunity to request, only one mass intentions per month per parishioner is allowed.
- We cannot hold lists of future requests for intentions.
- Donations are not required for Mass intentions. If you wish to make a donation, please simply add it into your regular offertory.
- To request a mass intention, please email or call the parish office at office@stjosephorlando.org or 407-275-0841.
- Mass cards are available upon request.

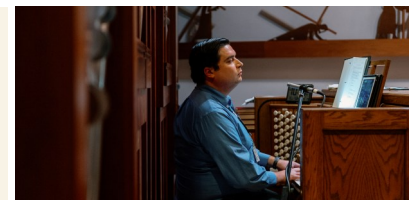

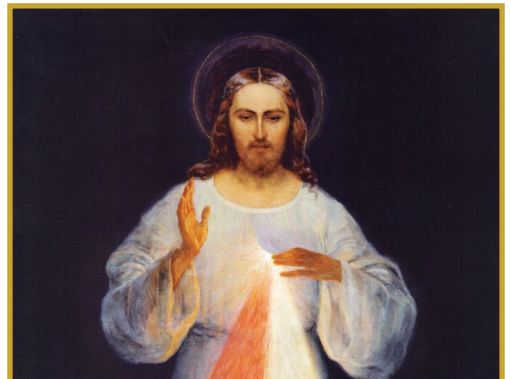

THE DIVINE MERCY NOVENA

Jesus asked St. Faustina that the Feast of the Divine Mercy be prepared for by a Novena to the Divine Mercy, beginning on Good Friday. The Divine Mercy Novena is a special nine-day prayer offered to Jesus. While it may be prayed at any time, it is most commonly prayed in the days leading up to Divine Mercy Sunday.
